ACT-SO GUIDELINES

Photography

The process, art and technique of capturing images with an analog or digital camera

Examples include but are not limited to: Black and white photographs, color photographs, digital or analog photographs, photograms, other experimental photography, etc.

Requirements

- 1. No more than six (6) photographs can be submitted or one (1) collage of work.
- 2. The photographs and/or mounting boards must be no larger than 20x16 inches and mounted on white, black, or gray color boards.
- The contestant is required to make a minimum three (3) minute oral presentation, explaining the methods or techniques used in developing the project.
- 4. The National Office will provide display tables.
- Gold medalists advancing to the National Competition level will be required to submit images of their entries via mail.

Contestants Will Be Judged By The Following Criteria

• Choice of film (15pts)

Black and white, color slide or color negative

Cleanness (15 pts)
Composition (20 pts)
Effective use of light (35 pts)
Mounting of photographs (15 pts)
